The History of Bayview Wildwood Resort

The Stanton Family tradition of warm hospitality began over 120 years ago. In the summer of 1884, Captain Tom Stanton and his wife, Ellen, first welcomed guests to the original Stanton House located on Sparrow Lake at Port Stanton.

Captain Tom settled on Sparrow Lake in 1875, selecting land where the Sparrow Lake Camp is today. He'd been working as a steamboat captain on Lake Couchiching and decided the time was right to start his own navigation business on the Severn River.


He launched the steamer "Pioneer" in 1875. The boat provided a water link from the railway station at Severn Bridge to settlements on the shores of Sparrow Lake.

Tom moved his family to the south shore of Sparrow Lake in 1884, so his children could attend the nearby school. That same year he offered accommodation to some of the fishermen who'd been camping in the area - hence the beginning of Stanton House.

In 1905, Tom's sons Bert and Frank built a 70-foot steamboat called "The Lakefield" and started the Sparrow Lake Steamer Line. The brothers searched a long time for the tree that would form the Lakefield's keel, one that had a natural curve for the bow. They built the ship in Bayview Bay, near the present Walton House building of Bayview Wildwood Resort. The ship carried 200 passengers in comfort, offering a heated lounge for cooler days.



The steamer "Lakefield", was built in 1905, on the Bayview Bay shore (where Walton House now stands) At the same time, the Stanton's were busy lobbying the Canadian Northern Railway to swing by Sparrow Lake. The surveyor's line bypassed the lake completely, but railway officials changed their mind when Tom Stanton offered them land for a station at Sparrow Lake, free of charge. The line from Toronto to Parry Sound opened in 1907.

The arrival of the railway greatly increased tourism to the area. From 1907 to the early 60s, members of the Stanton family owned and operated several summer lodges including Bayview Lodge, Wildwood Inn, Lakeshore House and Wild Echo Lodge. Bayview Wildwood Resorts originated at the consolidation of all four of these properties in the early 70s and commenced year-round operations in 1981 as one of Ontario's prominent four season resort destinations.

The Stanton family of today, is the fifth generation to live and work in Port Stanton. The family has acquired a lifetime of experience and know-how in the tourism business. Their business continues to thrive through careful attention to their guests, ingenuity and vision. They launched a new and unique fractional cottage development, The Cottages at Port Stanton (Cottages I), on the original site of Wild Echo Lodge and it has become a landmark success in this emerging tourism development trend. Cottages II served as an extension of their fractional cottage ownership offering on Sparrow Lake.

Resort Buildings

Wildwood Inn

The Front Desk is located just inside the entrance of the Wildwood Inn and is generally open from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. (however in the off-season,

office hours may vary). The Crusader Lounge (lobby) is open 24 hours, where there is coffee, hot water, a microwave, casual seating, and a television with

digital cable service.

Next to the Front Desk is our Echo's Dining Lounge where you can enjoy your

meals while taking in a breathtaking view of Sparrow Lake.

On the second floor there are two meeting rooms - Eleanor North and

Eleanor South.

On the lower level is the Glympse meeting room and bathrooms equipped

with an infant change table. In the summer months the Glympse becomes Walter's Pub, providing a lakefront patio. Adjacent to the Pub is the Winter

Recreation equipment room, which is accessible from the lakeside.

Lakeshore House

Indoor recreational facilities include heated pool, exercise equipment, squash court, basketball court, and games room. The games room offers ping-pong,

billiards, foosball, and video games. Games room equipment is available at

the Front Desk.

Walton House

This building contains twelve suites and the Cedar Meeting Rooms. To enter Cedar East and Cedar West, follow the patio stone walkway down the hill and enter from the lakeside.

Glyde Hall

Located near the entrance of the resort, across from Stanton Bros. Store, the Glyde Hall features a meeting room and washrooms.

Waterfront Building

This building is located in front of the Wildwood Inn on the water. In the summer months, you can find all of your outdoor sporting equipment; including boat rentals, kayaks, canoes, and paddle-boards here.

Conference Meeting Rooms

Cedar Room (East and West)

Located on the lower level of Walton House. Enter from the lakeside.

Glympse

Located on the lower level of the Wildwood Inn. Access from the Main Floor or lakeside.

Eleanor (North and South)

Located on the second floor of the Wildwood Inn. Access from the Main Floor.

Glyde Hall

Located near the entrance of the property, across from the Stanton Bros. Store.

Port Stanton Activities Year Round

Echo's Dining Lounge

Overlooking beautiful Sparrow Lake, the Echo's Dining Lounge offers a superb dining experience for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. The dining room is located in the Wildwood Inn, next to the Front Desk.

Echo's Lounge

The Echo's Lounge is the place to go for entertainment (seasonal) and evening cocktails. The Echo's Lounge is located in the Wildwood Inn and has a superb view of Sparrow Lake. This multi-purpose room is utilized for dining, cocktails, and special events throughout the year.

Entertainment

Live entertainment is present at the resort most weekends during family vacation times. Enjoy a variety of family educational shows, comedy, magic, musicians, stage variety shows, bands, DJ's, children's entertainers, and more.

Exercise Room

Keep in shape in the exercise room located in Lakeshore House on the lower level. Exercise equipment includes: two treadmills, elliptical trainer, two recumbent cycles, dumbbells and floor mats. The Exercise Room is open daily from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Fishing

Sparrow Lake and the Severn River provide an active fishery in both the "warm season" and for ice fishing. You can fish off the docks or rent a boat from the Recreation Centre at the resort.

Games Room

Enjoy video games, billiards, ping-pong, or foosball with your family in the Games Room. Located in the lower level of Lakeshore House, the Games Room is open daily from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. Equipment is available to sign out at the Front Office.

Hiking

Enjoy the beautiful countryside while hiking through the grandeur of the Canadian Shield wilderness on several trails leading from the resort. Guided hikes are offered at specific times throughout the year.

Indoor Pool

Located on the lower level of Lakeshore House, the indoor pool can be enjoyed year-round. Change rooms with showers are located right next to the pool. Open from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily.

Recreation Programs

Supervised children's programs are offered throughout the year most weekends and during family vacation times. While the children are occupied and having fun in the programs, adult guests can relax or join in the adult activities being offered, such as guided hikes, aerobics classes, painting classes, and cocktail seminars.

Port Stanton Activities Spring, Summer, and Fall

Badminton

A badminton court is available for games in the summer season.

Baseball and Volleyball

Grab your gloves and have fun at the volleyball court and baseball diamond located on the other side of the railway track. The walkway to the track crossing is adjacent to the Wildwood Inn.

Basketball

A basketball court is conveniently located right next to the Playground.

Beach

Adults and children can make use of the large sandy beach with floating raft, water trampoline, and iceberg. Adjacent to the Outdoor Pool and Hot Tub, beside the Waterfront building.

Bicycling

Choose to cycle around the property or local country roads. Touring bicycles and child tow-trailers are available for rental from the Waterfront building. Helmets are mandatory.

Canoes

Paddle along the shoreline of Sparrow Lake or on the Severn River in one of our fleet of canoes.

Children's Playground

Children can enjoy a variety of safe and fun playground equipment right next to the Wildwood Inn.

Bayview Indoor "Treehouse" Playground

Located in Lakeshore House our indoor playground will keep children busy all day as they climb, jump and explore our treehouse.

Fishing Boats

Choose from the basic 14 ft. 8 h.p. models - or you can upgrade to a 16 ft. bass boat complete with steering and speed controls, flooring, live well and 25 h.p. engine. Rental fees apply. See the Front Desk for pricing and availability.

Golfing

For golf enthusiasts, there are four challenging golf courses within a 30-minute drive. The closest, Lake St. George Golf Course, is a championship course just 5 km away. Check out Bayview Wildwood's golf packages!

Historical Shoreline Pontoon Boat Cruises

One-hour guided historical boat cruises are offered throughout the "warm" season. Get comfortable in one of our Pontoon boats while recreation staff take you on a shoreline cruise around the area.

Kayaks

Recreational kayaks are a fun way to enjoy trips on the lake. Choose from single or tandem kayaks.

Lawn Games

Sign out bocce ball, croquet, or horseshoes at the Waterfront building and have an active afternoon of lawn games with your friends and family.

Outdoor Pool

Enjoy outdoor swimming in a beautiful heated outdoor pool overlooking Sparrow Lake. Adult swims, water fitness, and water games are offered at the outdoor pool throughout the summer season.

Paddle-boards

Drift atop the waters of Sparrow Lake on your own paddle-board. Balance easily on one of these sleek water rafts and enjoy the calm waters and lakeside sights.

Shuffleboard

Play this favourite resort game on one of two outdoor shuffleboard courts. Located next to the Outdoor Pool and next to the Bayside Cottage.

Summer Water Sports

"Summer Water Sports", a professional water recreation service, joins the Bayview Wildwood Resort team for the summer season. They offer waterskiing, knee boarding, and wakeboarding runs and lessons. Services are available at an extra cost. During the summer season, dial "138" for more information.

Tennis

Two tennis courts are on the resort site with one court being lit for night use. Courts are located next to the Baseball Diamond and between the Glyde Hall and Lakeshore House.

Port Stanton Activities Winter

Broomball

Broomball continues to be a popular winter sport. Outfit your friends and family with our broom ball equipment and have a terrific game.

Cross Country Skiing

Ski through the winter forests on a variety of groomed and track-set cross-country ski trails. Skis, boots, and poles, are available for adults and children at the Recreation Centre.

Curling

Come and enjoy this unique opportunity to try your hand at some lake curling. Rinks are made on Sparrow Lake, weather permitting.

Horse-Drawn Wagon Rides

Hop aboard a wagon pulled by a team of magnificent horses. What better way to enjoy a crisp winter afternoon! Rides offered throughout the winter season. Check activity schedule for times.

Skating

Throughout the winter there is a maintained rink (lit for night use) on the lake, depending on the weather conditions. Skates for both adults and children are available at the Recreation Centre.


Snowshoeing
