The History of Bayview Wildwood Resort

The Stanton Family tradition of warm hospitality began over 120 years ago. In the summer of 1884, Captain Tom Stanton and his wife, Ellen, first welcomed guests to the original Stanton House located on Sparrow Lake at Port Stanton

The Stanton's lobbied the Canadian Northern Railway to swing by Sparrow Lake, and offered them land for a station at Sparrow Lake, free of charge. The line from Toronto to Parry Sound opened in 1907. Bayview Wildwood Resorts originates from the consolidation of four properties run by Stanton family members in the early 70s and commenced year-round operations in 1981 as one of Ontario's prominent four season resort destinations.

The Stanton family of today, is the sixth generation to live and work in Port Stanton. The family has acquired a lifetime of experience and know-how in the tourism business. Their business continues to thrive through careful attention to their guests, ingenuity and vision.
